OUR PROGRAMS & OUR IMPACT

Simply hearing the word "art" completely transformed one little girl's hospital experience. Walking into the clinic's art room for the first time, she got to explore the depths of the Arts For Life supply closets and lose herself in the art—finding textures and treasures that she didn't know she could find in the hospital! In spite of her upcoming appointment, her imagination and enthusiasm bubbled over as she meticulously chose her paper. For the next 90 minutes, the clinic disappeared and her art studio came to life! She knew what it would mean for other kids too, proclaiming,

"This is so great for all the kids that have to come here because now they have something fun to do!"

CLINIC ART TABLES & BEDSIDE STUDIOS

Individual and small group art and music sessions that bring supportive and engaging creative opportunities into the hospital, encouraging a more positive healthcare experience in hospital and clinic waiting rooms.

HEARTBEAT SESSIONS

Connecting a young patient with our larger musical community. Participants can choose or write a song to be set to the rhythm of their heartbeat, which is then recorded by professional musicians at world-renowned Echo Mountain Recording Studio in Asheville, NC.

ARTIVITY KITS

All-inclusive art kits with instructions, materials, and creative ideas and activities made especially for patients - of all ages and developmental levels.

4,000 art and music sessions, sharing new materials and methods, while inspiring kids of all ages

Over 4,000 Artivity Art Kits were distributed throughout our three hospital partners, featuring 14 new designs bursting at the seams with fun activities for kids to get creative whenever they want.

19,000 additional hours of creativity to kids








